Art

Overview

At Lindridge St Lawrence CE VA Primary we believe that a high-quality art and design education should engage, inspire and challenge pupils, equipping them with the knowledge and skills to experiment, invent and create their own works of art, craft and design. As children progress, they should be able to think critically and develop a more rigorous understanding of art and design. They should also know how art and design both reflect and shape our history, and contribute to the culture, creativity and wealth of our nation.

Intent

At Lindridge St Lawrence CE VA Primary School we will ensure that all children will: • produce creative work, exploring their ideas and recording their experiences • become proficient in drawing, painting, sculpture and other art, craft and design techniques • evaluate and analyse creative works using the language of art, craft and design • know about great artists, craft makers and designers, and understand the historical and cultural development of their art forms.

Implementation

Art is taught in all year groups through at least one topic per term, children will be given time to develop their skills and appreciation of art. At Lindridge St Lawrence CE VA Primary School the children are encouraged to use a variety of materials, media and art forms to record their creative work. We encourage their creativity, experimentation and observations as well as their technical skills. The children learn to appreciate great art and talk about what it means to them as well as using it for an inspiration for their own work. All children have a sketch book which moves with them as they travel through school as a record of the progress and journey that they have taken with their art work.

<u>Impact</u>

The children will see visual art as an art form to be enjoyed and appreciated. They will experience a wide range of different art forms and will be confident and secure in themselves as an artist, willing to have a go, experiment and produce their own art work. Creativity at Lindridge St Lawrence CE VA Primary School will be nurtured; children will be encouraged to take creative risks and discover their own style as well as learning key skills and techniques. We will have a community of children who enjoy and appreciate art across the whole school.
